Last practice

Key notes:

- We have **Verner** effects in 2 and 4. I don't care whether you go with *z or *r for Verner effects from *s. (Modern German *kiesen* ~ *erkoren* still shows this.)
- I've stayed with the very **early forms** of 'ei' for class I infinitives and 'e' for III when a nasal follows.
- Don't forget the three **wrinkles**: class IV PretPI (ē) and class V PretPI (ē) and Part (e).
